

OTHER KEY EWG INITIATIVES

ENVIRONMENTALLY SOUND ENERGY INFRASTRUCTURE INITIATIVE, PHASE 2

AT EWG22, Members noted the final reports for phase 1, '*Environmentally Sound Energy Infrastructure in the Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation: Policies to Facilitate the Transfer and Uptake of Efficient and Clean Energy Technologies*' and '*Environmentally Sound Energy Infrastructure in the Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation: Energy Sector Good Policy Practices*'. It was decided that discussion on the outcomes and recommendations contained in the reports would be held once Phase 2 was completed.

The deliverables of Phase 2 will be three analytical research reports that will contain an analysis (including case studies) of energy/environmental policy practices that promote the establishment of efficient and environmentally sound energy infrastructure.

On the 19th December 2001, the APEC Secretariat advised the Project Overseer that the BMC gave approval to extend the disbursement deadline of the above project for one year to 31st December 2002. The extension will allow the Project Overseer (Canada) sufficient time to complete the work, obtain agreement from the EWG and leave time for the APEC Secretariat to complete the required disbursement.
